Eligibility is based on the following:

- Applicants must have a diagnosis of a craniofacial difference. (i.e. Cleft Lip and Palate)
- Applicants must reside in Maine.
- Applicants must be a high school senior currently attending school in Maine and on track for graduating in Spring of 2019.
- All applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2019.
- A 200-500 word essay is required with the application.
